Housing Rates: Summer 2008

*Housing accommodations are subject to a 14.5% DC occupancy tax, unless proof of exemption is provided.
Food service is subject to a 10% DC food tax, unless proof of exemption is provided.
Other services are subject to a 5.75% DC sales tax, unless proof of exemption is provided.*

HOUSING SERVICES

(n.b. All rates include access to the Yates Field House.)

Short term housing (less than three weeks) in a double occupancy room:

Residence Hall Rooms: (single or double occupancy rooms)

Village C Room (with private baths)	\$60/room/night
Copley Room (with a shared bath and conjoined double room)	\$52/room/night
Copley Room (with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
LXR Room (double room with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
LXR Room (single room with floor bath)	\$30/room/night
Darnall Room (with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
New South Room (with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
Harbin Room (with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
McCarthy, Kennedy or Reynolds Room (double room with floor bath)	\$46/room/night
McCarthy, Kennedy or Reynolds Room (single room with floor bath)	\$30/room/night

Long term housing:

Apartment Size	Apartment Rate
4 person apartment (Village A, Henle, Nevils, Alumni Square)	\$120/apartment/night
5 person apartment (Henle, Nevils)	\$150/apartment/night

Rooms in both residence halls and apartments are cleaned only at the beginning of the stay. Linens are not replaced and rooms are not cleaned by staff.

LINEN SERVICES:

- ? Linen is not included in the cost of housing in any building.
- ? **Standard Service** linen can be offered to conference groups staying 14 nights or fewer (2 sheets, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, 1 blanket, and 1 towel per person) at the rate of \$10.00/person. The bed(s) is made and bath linen is placed in the room at check-in only.
- ? **Self-Service** linen can be offered to conference groups staying 14 nights or fewer (2 sheets, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, 1 blanket and 1 towel per person) at the rate of \$8.00/person. The linen is neatly folded and placed on each bed at check-in only.
- ? **Pillow and Blanket** – can be offered to groups and placed in the room at check-in only at the rate of \$5.00/person
- ? **Linen exchange (weekly)** is only available for groups staying longer than 14 days. The rate is \$1.00/person. Laundry facilities are available on campus.

Parking:

On-campus parking is limited. Requests for conference staff parking must be submitted in writing to the Office of Conference and Guest Services at least fourteen days prior to arrival. All requests are subject to approval by the Office of Transportation Management.

Security:

Guard *approximately \$25/officer/hour, 4 hour minimum.*

Some functions will require officers from the GU Department of Public Safety, at the cost of the event sponsor. Need and level of security staffing required is determined by DPS based on event size, presence of alcohol, event location, and other factors.
